There will be a Code Club for Year 4, 5 and 6 children starting after school on Tuesdays. This club will be start on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> September and will run from 4.15pm to 5.15pm. It will last for 12 weeks and will end on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> December.

Please indicate on the reply slip how you would like your child to leave the club at 5.15pm. If you wish for them to walk home on their own, please ensure a 'walking home' letter has been completed. Until after Easter, this applies only to Year 5 and Year 6. See Mrs Stanton for more details.

Even though this is a club run by a volunteer, we would expect the same high level of behaviour and attendance that we get for teacher run clubs. Constant poor behaviour or attendance may result in the opportunity being taken away for individuals and being offered to others who may be on a waiting list.
