Staff	3,540 metres (2.2 miles)

Well done to all the classes and the staff runners (Mrs Wallace, Mrs Vallons, Mrs Smith, Miss Gray, Mrs Hume and Mr Waterfield) for clocking up some great distances. **The overall distance that our school ran for Sport Relief was 68.59km or 42.6 miles.** A huge well done to everyone and thank you for your donations.
