At a recent governors meeting, it was decided that school meals should remain at the current price of £2.40 for the coming year. This is reviewed on an annual basis by the governing body. It was also decided that Breakfast club charges should remain at current rate.

Year 6 Enterprise work

In Year 6 this week, the children have produced almost 150 bee friendly seed bombs in preparation for the launch of their enterprise project.

These seed bombs contain a mixture of wild flower seeds, aimed at attracting bees to your garden. You simply crumble the seed over your garden to release the seeds. Many thanks to Morrisons for donating flour, paprika and compost – all elements that have gone into the seed bombs.

There will be a section on our school website where you will be able to read more information and watch a video explaining the reasons behind the project.

Next week Year 6 are planning to create a table presentation for you so that you can view the finished articles in the playground as you collect your children. They will not be selling the items at that point, but there will be order forms to collect for you to order your seed bombs. They are being sold for £3.00 each. The children have decided to donate half of all money to The British Bee Charity and the other half of money raised will be put towards creating and the up keep of the Year 6 bee friendly garden, which is taking shape in our allotment area.

Year 6 are also preparing to deliver a presentation to our school governors in the coming weeks, over Google Teams.

Year 6 will be posting on the whole school story of Class Dojo next week about their enterprise work. There will also be downloads and helpful advice about creating bee friendly spaces in your own gardens on our website. The 'Bee-Kind' section on our website has been designed and created by Year 6.

We hope that you will support the enterprise work by Year 6 by buying one of their seed bombs in the coming weeks.
