Free School Meals

Friday 29th January

Are you eligible to receive free school meals for your child? Even if they are already having a free dinner because they are in Reception or Key Stage 1, you can still apply for the 'traditional' free school meals and if successful, school will receive extra funds to support and improve your child's education.

Why should I apply for 'traditional' free school meals if my child is already having a free meal?

- There are a number of reasons why you should still apply:
- Your child will immediately become eligible for free school milk.
- You will get help with the costs of music tuition.
- If your circumstances do not change, your child will automatically receive 'traditional' free school meals when
- they move into Year 3, without the need for applying.
- School will receive Pupil Premium income for every child who is registered for 'traditional' free school meals.
- All of these benefits even apply even if your child would prefer to bring a packed lunch to school they just need to be registered for 'traditional' free school meals.

Would I qualify?

- If you are in receipt of any one of the following benefits, then you may be eligible to apply and help us raise more funds:
- Child Tax Credit (Families receiving Working Tax Credit are not eligible)
- Income Support
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit
