Dinner Money

Please can we remind you that dinner money accounts should always be in credit. There are a number of accounts which are gathering significant arrears. You are able to log on to your account and check the balance. If we find the account amassing significant arrears and no attempt has been made to reduce the arrears after contacting you several times, it may be that your child will no longer be able to have a school lunch and a packed lunch will need to be provided. In extreme cases, it is regrettable that legal advice will be sought. Thank you for helping keep the balances in credit and therefore helping the school manage its balance sheets.

Breakfast Club & Afterschool Club

If you would like your child to attend Breakfast or After School Club, please contact the office to book your child in. If you are using the service for the first time, forms will need to be filled in prior to you using the service. Breakfast Club starts at 8.00am and a healthy and nutritious breakfast will be given to your child. Please note that if you arrive at Breakfast Club after 8.30am, breakfast will have finished and so this will need to have been had at home. After School Club starts at 3.15pm and runs until 4.15pm. You may collect your child at any point during this time. The cost for Breakfast and After School club is £3.00 for the first child and £2.50 for any siblings that are also in the club. These prices are reviewed on an annual basis by the governing body. Payments can be made to the school office.

Magic Breakfast

Since last February, children have had the opportunity to have a portion of bagel at registration time. Over the next few weeks this scheme will be coming to an end and we will be reducing the amounts of bagel offered to children, as we use our stocks up. Whilst stocks last, children in breakfast club will still be offered bagels. The Magic Breakfast scheme was in no way a substitute for breakfast at home and children should continue coming to school with a healthy breakfast inside them.
