<u>Uniform</u>

From 1st December you will be able to purchase school uniform online using the website from Emblematic. When this goes live there will be a link to the correct page on our website to make the process easy. This will replace the uniform sale we have in school in May. However, we will still have a couple of times later in the year when you can come into school to check sizes of clothes. More information about the process of purchasing online will be sent out in a separate letter at a later date. Orders can be delivered to your house for a charge or they can be delivered to school free of charge and we can hand them out.

A new addition to our uniform will be a navy Forest School hoodie, similar to our already established red school hoodie. This will be able to be worn as part of our school uniform. We have also taken the decision to allow Reception and Key Stage 1 children to purchase both the Forest School hoodie and the school red hoodie and to wear them in school. All children take part in Forest School and we felt it was unfair restricting just Key Stage 2 children to this. We are also exploring an addition to the PE kit for Year 5 (and Year 6 when we have them). We are currently awaiting more information from Emblematic before a final decision is made.
