### Uniform

If you missed the cut off date for free home delivery from Emblematic, you can still order from them and have your items delivered for a charge. Emblematic have advised that all orders should be placed before 1<sup>st</sup> August in order to be ready for September.

Some parents and carers may be aware that in the early days of the pandemic, guidance and advice on uniform and how often to wash it was circulating and you may be worried about how many items of uniform you may need to buy. In the latest in a long line of updates from the Department for Education, they included the following: "There is no need for anything other than normal personal hygiene and washing of clothes following a day in a school. Uniforms do not need to be cleaned any more often or differently than usual."
