Coronavirus

With our thoughts turning a little to Christmas, it can be easy to forget the situation we find ourselves in regarding Coronavirus. It is still with us in the community and at present, we have two children in school who have tested positive on a PCR test.

Please can we ask you that if your child has any symptoms of a cold or a cough that they take a lateral flow test. If this returns as negative and they are well enough to be in school, they should continue as normal. If the lateral flow returns as positive, a PCR test must be booked and a negative result received before they return to school.

Please inform school if your child is taking a PCR test. This can be done either via Class Dojo or we still have our email address running, specifically for this:
