teaches children to code while they play. Using a free App (Blockly or Go) Dash can be programmed to respond to voice, navigate objects, talk, make noises, dance and even sing. Blockly introduces advanced concepts of coding through playful projects and puzzles, exploring variables, events, conditionals and much more. Whereas Go allows
