Illness

Please be vigil and aware of the symptoms of Strep A and Scarlet Fever. What to look out for:

Common symptoms of scarlet fever include a sore throat, often with a red, swollen tongue, headache, fever and pinkish or red body rash with a sandpapery feel. On darker skin, the rash can be more difficult to detect visually but will have a sandpapery feel.

Scarlet fever is typically treated with a course of antibiotics.

If a pupil has scarlet fever, parents/carers should keep them at home until at least 24 hours after the start of antibiotic treatment to avoid spreading the infection to others.
