School Admissions

The portal to request a place at Secondary school from September 2022 is now open and will close on 31st October.

You can log on via the Northumberland County Council website. Applications after this date will be classed as 'late' and will not be processed until all 'on time' applications have been allocated. Although it seems a long time away, it will be soon upon us, so please ensure you complete the process if your child is in Year 6.

The portal for Reception places in September 2022 will open later in the term and we will inform you.

Wellbeing week - Monday 4th October

Our wellbeing week will be incorporating lots of safety work with the children, involving personal safety and dedicated lessons about keeping safe online. Online safety is part of the curriculum that is taught throughout the year throughout a variety of subjects and discussions. However, during this week, there will be more emphasis on the subject, especially as it is at the start of a school year. We will also be incorporating healthy lifestyle in the week.

Harvest

We have decided to collect for Harvest during our Wellbeing week. We have decided to donate the food collected between two charities. The first charity is the Wansbeck Food Bank, who we have worked closely with before. The food collected will be made available for those families in our area who need the support of the foodbank. The second charity is the Pegswood Community Hub. The food donated to the Hub will be distributed to our local elderly



residents. We think that both charities are a worthwhile cause at this particular time.

We will be collecting food items (described below) between the dates Monday 4th October and Friday 8th October rather than on any one particular day. Please either give you child the donation of food to bring into school during that week, or donate directly to the school office. Once all the food has been collected, we will halve the amount and it will be collected by the Hub and Pegswood Co-op, who collect for the foodbank.

We have been asked that donations should be tinned foods, dried foods or packet foods and that the foods should all be in date. Thank you in advance for any donation you feel you can make.
