Code Club

Code Club is a nationwide network of free volunteer-led after school coding clubs for children aged 9-11 and so we are offering this club to Year 4 and 5 children. We have space for 20 children, which means each child will have access to a computer individually. If there are more than 20 children interested in joining the club we will pull names from a hat to decide on the participants. Sam Willcox, (parent of Henry in Year 5 and also a Governor of school) will be our volunteer lead. The club will be on Tuesday nights from 4.15pm – 5.15pm at school. If your child is currently doing Sports Club on a Tuesday they will be able to stay at school between 4.00pm and 4.15pm.
