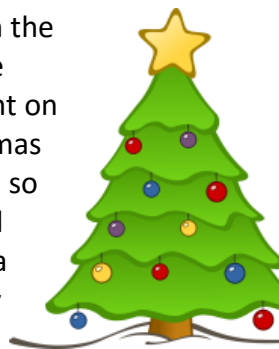

If you can pre-order on School Grid (Live Kitchen) before the day, it would be extremely helpful for planning. If you are unable to do this, please contact school to let us know. Children can still order a Christmas meal on the morning, but knowing before-hand would help the catering team. If your child does not normally have a school dinner, please ensure the payment of £2.40 is in an envelope with **your child's name, year group** and **'Christmas lunch'** clearly written on it. Payment is not required if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 as these children are funded by Universal Free School meals. If your child is in Years 3-6 and you are in receipt of Free School Meals, payment is also not required.
