Admissions Portal

The admissions portal for secondary school is now live for parents of Year 6 children on the Northumberland County Council website. There is a link directly to it from our 'News' section on our school website.

Ashington Academy have changed their admissions policy to include Pegswood in their catchment area, starting with our current Year 6 children. This will mean that our children will be in a better position to be admitted than those children outside the catchment area, with no siblings.

We hope you have managed to go along to the open evenings and get a taste of the different secondary schools and what they have to offer.

The portal on the Northumberland County Council website closes on Thursday 3Ist October 2023 (during half term). It is imperative that you do not miss this deadline; otherwise, your application will go to the bottom of the pile.

Please ensure that you put more than one school on your application, when listing your preferences, even if you do not want them to go to the second or third-choice school. If you do not receive your first option, with no other choice on the form, the priority of the application drops drastically, meaning you could be allocated a school further away from home.
