## Spring 2nd Half Term 2025

Welcome to the second part of the Spring Term. Teachers have briefly outlined the learning happening in their classroom over the next half term. We hope you find it helpful.



- ★ In maths, we will be identifying fractions of wholes, recognising mixed numbers and improper fractions. We will be finding equivalent fractions and adding and subtracting fractions.
- ★ In English, we will be reading The Iron Man and we will be asking questions and making predictions. We will look at powerful language including similes and expanded noun phrases. We will be writing a diary entry and a conversation. Finally, we will be creating our own imaginary creature and writing a story about what happens when it encounters humans.

## ★ In science, we will be continuing with our States of Matter unit investigating the conditions that affect the rate of evaporation. We will identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle. At the end, we will be holding a States of Matter party to recap our learning.

## ★ In history, we will be learning about the Ancient Greek civilisation including their religious beliefs and the importance of The Parthenon. We will be researching the Ancient Olympic Games and writing a recount of The Battle of Marathon using artefacts and other sources of evidence.

★ In computing, we will look at the internet as a network of networks, which need to be kept secure. We will learn that the World Wide Web is part of the internet, and will be given opportunities to explore the World Wide Web. Finally, we will evaluate online content to decide how honest, accurate, or reliable it is, and understand the consequences of false information.
