## Colour Run

Our Colour Run is creeping closer. There is an advert that will accompany the newsletter with all the information about the colour run. However, below are a few information points.

- ❖ 11.30 – 1.30 pm: Parents and carers are invited in to browse the various stalls and to have a picnic lunch. The picnic can be brought in from home or children can order a school packed lunch. There will also be a pizza van on site. This will be pre orders only, as they have been in the past. A pizza menu will be sent out next week.
- ❖ 1.30 – 2.30 pm: The Colour Run will take place with groups running at different times. Everybody will not be running all at the same time.
- ❖ Adults may run with their child / children.
- ❖ 2.00 pm: Ice Cream van will arrive
- ❖ Once children have run, they may get an ice cream with their adult and depart for home with their adult.
- ❖ Children may participate without an adult, but children without an adult will stay in school until the end of the school day.
- ❖ After the run, there will be an opportunity to get your child's or your group's photograph. The photographs will not be available on the day, but will be distributed after.
- ❖ The event is open only to children who are currently attending Pegswood Primary School. This includes both the Colour Run and the picnic. Children under school-age may attend the picnic but will not be allowed to take part in the Colour Run.

## Clothes to wear:

- ❖ An old white t-shirt is best. The paint we are using is specifically designed for the Colour Run use, but may stain clothes, when washed. A cold wash usually gets the colour out though.
- ❖ Sunglasses or other eye protection must be worn. Without suitable eye protection, children and adults will not be allowed to run.

We hope it will be a fantastic afternoon. There will be a permission form that will be sent out via Google Forms to allow your child to participate. We will also be sending out a disclaimer, via Google Forms, that must be returned to school to indicate which (if any),

adult will be participating. There will also be a sponsorship form sent out to raise money for new Ipads and for the Christmas pantomime.

For one of our stalls, we require screw top bottles of wine. If you feel that you can donate a (full) screw top bottle of wine, please drop this into the front office, where we will trust Miss Kennedy to store them!

### **Library Books**
