Spring 2nd Half Term 2025

Welcome to the second part of the Spring Term. Teachers have briefly outlined the learning happening in their classroom over the next half term. We hope you find it helpful.



- ★ In maths we will be continuing with multiplication and division, which will be, the five times table and dividing by five, the IO's times table and dividing by IO. We will then move onto length and height; measuring in centimetres, metres, comparing length and height. Mass; comparing mass, measuring in grams, measuring in kilograms, comparing volume and capacity, measuring in millilitres litres and temperature.
- ★ In English, we will be reading a range of traditional fairy tales to support the writing of a setting description based on Trimpoli's Tower. We will be looking to use punctuation - question marks and capital letters for proper nouns and commas in a list. Grammar, coordinating conjunctions and expanded noun phrases. We will be looking to read and write our common exception words; wild, grass, pass, most, plant, could, path, would, even and climb.

- ★ In history, we will be learning about The Great Fire of London, when and how this happened and how it could have been prevented, what we can learn from this and changes that have been made. We will also write a recount as Samuel Pepys.
- ★ In science we are looking at living things and their habitats. We will identify things that are living, not living and never alive, life processes using 'Mrs Gren' (The characteristics of life can be remembered using the acronym MRS GREN. This acronym is often used to help remember all the necessary features of living organisms: Movement, Respiration, Sensitivity, Growth, Reproduction, Excretion and Nutrition). Animal classification, their habitats and the different food chains.
- ★ In art, we will be using clay to make a tile.
