Spring 2nd Half Term 2025

Welcome to the second part of the Spring Term. Teachers have briefly outlined the learning happening in their classroom over the next half term. We hope you find it helpful.



- ★ In maths, we will be working on long multiplication and short division. We will also be working on multiplying fractions and finding fractions of amounts.
- ★ In English, we will continue reading the brilliant 'Twitch' by M.G Leonard. We will use the book as inspiration for our woodland setting descriptions and will continue the nature theme as we move on to some poetry work using the beautifully illustrated anthology, 'The Lost Words'.
- ★ In science, we will learn about the properties of solids, liquids, and gases and investigate which materials make the best thermal insulators and which materials are magnetic. We will investigate how to separate materials using separation methods such as filtering, sieving, evaporation, and magnets.

Year 5

- ★ In history, we will continue to learn about the Maya civilisation, including where and when they lived, and how their society was organised. We will learn about their religious beliefs and their many Gods. We will learn about Maya sport and their ball game, Pitz.
- ★ In RE, pupils will find out about parables from the Bible and learn ways in which many Christians try to make the world more like God's Kingdom by challenging injustice in their local area and around the world.
- ★ In PE, we will continue with our weekly swimming lessons.
- ★ In computing, we will start to create vector drawings. We will learn how to use different drawing tools to help us to create images. We will recognise that images in vector drawings are created using shapes and lines, and each element in the drawing is called an object.
