### **Library Books**

#### **School Meals**

From September 2025, school meals will remain at the price of £2.50. We will continue to have a summer and winter menu. The winter menu will run from September until Easter and the summer menu from Easter until the summer holidays. The winter menu will offer a main course and a jacket potato with the same fillings. There will be no sandwiches on offer. The summer menu will offer a main course and a choice of sandwiches. There will be no jacket potatoes on offer.

#### Colour Run

Our Colour Run is now only a week away. We are still waiting for the pizza menu for you to order. We will hopefully receive this on Monday and we will send it straight out to you. If you require a packed lunch from school, these are now online to order.

We still require screw top bottles of wine for one of the stalls. If you feel that you can donate a (full) screw top bottle of wine, please drop this into the front office.

The permission forms have been sent out today via Class Dojo. Please fill one in for each child you have to give permission for it to participate. We have also asked you to inform us who (if at all) the adult will be taking part with your child. There is no obligation for adults to take part and children without adults will still be able to participate, as long as we have had the permission form returned.

We ask that there be just one adult taking part for each child and all adults participating must be over I8. If children are in different Houses, one of the children can move in order to take part if only one parent is available.

A sponsorship form was sent out with children to try to raise money for new IPad and for the Christmas pantomime. There is absolutely no expectation that sponsor forms are completed and please donate only if you feel you can.

Please may we remind you that the event is open only to children who are currently attending Pegswood Primary School. This includes both the Colour Run and the picnic. Children under school age may attend the picnic but will not be allowed to take part in the Colour Run.

Below is a reminder of how things will shape up.

- ❖ II.30 I.30 pm: Parents and carers are invited in to browse the various stalls and to have a picnic lunch. The picnic can be brought in from home or children can order a school packed lunch. There will also be a pizza van on site. This will be pre orders only, as they have been in the past.
- ❖ 1.30 2.30 pm: The Colour Run will take place with groups running at different times. Not everybody will be running all at the same time.
- One adult may run with their child / children.
- 2.00 pm: Ice Cream van will arrive
- Once children have run, they may get an ice cream with their adult and depart for home with their adult.
- Children may participate without an adult, but children without an adult will stay in school until the end of the school day.
- ❖ After the run, there will be an opportunity to get your child's or your group's photograph. The photographs will not be available on the day, but will be distributed after.

#### Clothes to wear:

- An old white t-shirt is best. The paint we are using is specifically designed for the Colour Run use, but may stain clothes, when washed. A cold wash usually gets the colour out though.
- Sunglasses or other eye protection must be worn. Without suitable eye protection, children and adults will not be allowed to run.

#### **Uniform Orders**

If you wish to buy school uniform from our supplier – Emblematic, below are the cut off dates for orders.

- ♣ Order before I5th June and delivery can be arranged to School for free or home for a charge, before School closes for the summer.
- Order before 20<sup>th</sup> July and delivery can be arranged to School free or home for a charge, before School returns in September.

Of course, there is no obligation to buy from our supplier and local supermarkets stock the colour ranges that make up our uniform. We also have some second hand uniform in school for a small donation. Ask Miss Kennedy should you wish to use this.
